1. Encourage faculty to student interaction	Mail, Discussions, Chat and Whiteboard, Calendar, Syllabus, Who's Online, My Grades, My Progress
2. Encourage student to student interaction	Mail, Discussions, Chat, Whiteboard, Calendar, Who's Online, Groups
3. Promote active learning	URL, Content Files, Media Library, Search, Assessments, Notes, Chat and Whiteboard, Discussions
4. Communicate high expectations	Learning Module, Assessments
5. Facilitate time on task	Calendar, Media Library, Syllabus, Search, Assessments, Assignments, My Progress
6. Provide rich, rapid feedback	Chat and Whiteboard, Who's Online, My Grades, Assessments, Assignments, Media Library, Syllabus, Discussions, Groups, My Progress
7. Respect diverse learning	Learning Modules, Media Library, Chat and Whiteboard, Groups, My Progress
